This tune, Milton, may first have been printed in Walker's Southern Harmony, which quickly sold 600,000 copies after its 1854 printing. Its format is Shape Note. I've seen it notated in both 6/4 and 6/8.

The suggested speed is a dotted quarter or half (2 beats/measure) at 76-80.

The traditional speed for a jig which will be danced puts the beat at about 116.
